LIVE ON-AIR SIGNAL IN THE FIELD

Enables field crews to know when they're live on-air

LiveU's Tally Light lets your field reporters and camera operators know instantly when they're live on air, wherever they may be. Bringing the live studio experience outdoors, a red light indicator connected to the LiveU unit provides a live cue signaling that the camera is 'live'. This is particularly useful in remote multicamera productions.

An important addition to your broadcast toolbox, Tally Light is easy to implement with a one-time set up. Simply connect your production switcher via the Tally controller in the control room to one of your existing LiveU servers. Connected to the LiveU field units*, the Tally Light will immediately trigger the red light indication when the video stream goes live. The device will also provide a green indication when the unit is transmitting but not on-air.

One Tally controller can serve up to 16 SDI video channels with the mapping operated via the LiveU Central management platform.


